

Uniform Guidance 2 CFR 200 Office of Crime Victim Services October 1, 2024

While there were many changes to Uniform Guidance 2 CFR 200 that went into effect October 1, 2024, OCVS wanted to highlight the ones below for your awareness.

 The audit requirement threshold was raised from \$750,000 to \$1,000,000. If your grant manager has not contacted you about this condition, please reach out to them using the following language. "Hello,

I am reaching out to inform you that our agency expects to spend \$1,000,000 or more in federal financial assistance during the fiscal year(s) of the VOCA project."

- 2. The de minimis rate was raised from 10% to 15% of modified total direct costs (MTDC). This change is not automatic and does NOT mean that more funds will be provided to support the additional 5%. If you intend on using the higher rate please contact your grant manager via email and provide them a signed copy of the <u>Certification to Apply 15% De Minimis Indirect Cost Rate</u>.
- 3. The modified total direct cost (MTDC) subaward threshold increased from \$25,000 to \$50,000. This means that \$50,000 can be claimed towards indirect against subawards. If you are unsure if this applies to your OCVS funded grant, please reach out to your assigned financial grant manager.
- The equipment and supply threshold increased at the federal level from \$5,000 to \$10,000; however, Wisconsin's state procurement guidelines remain at \$5,000 so this change will not affect OCVS funded grants.
