

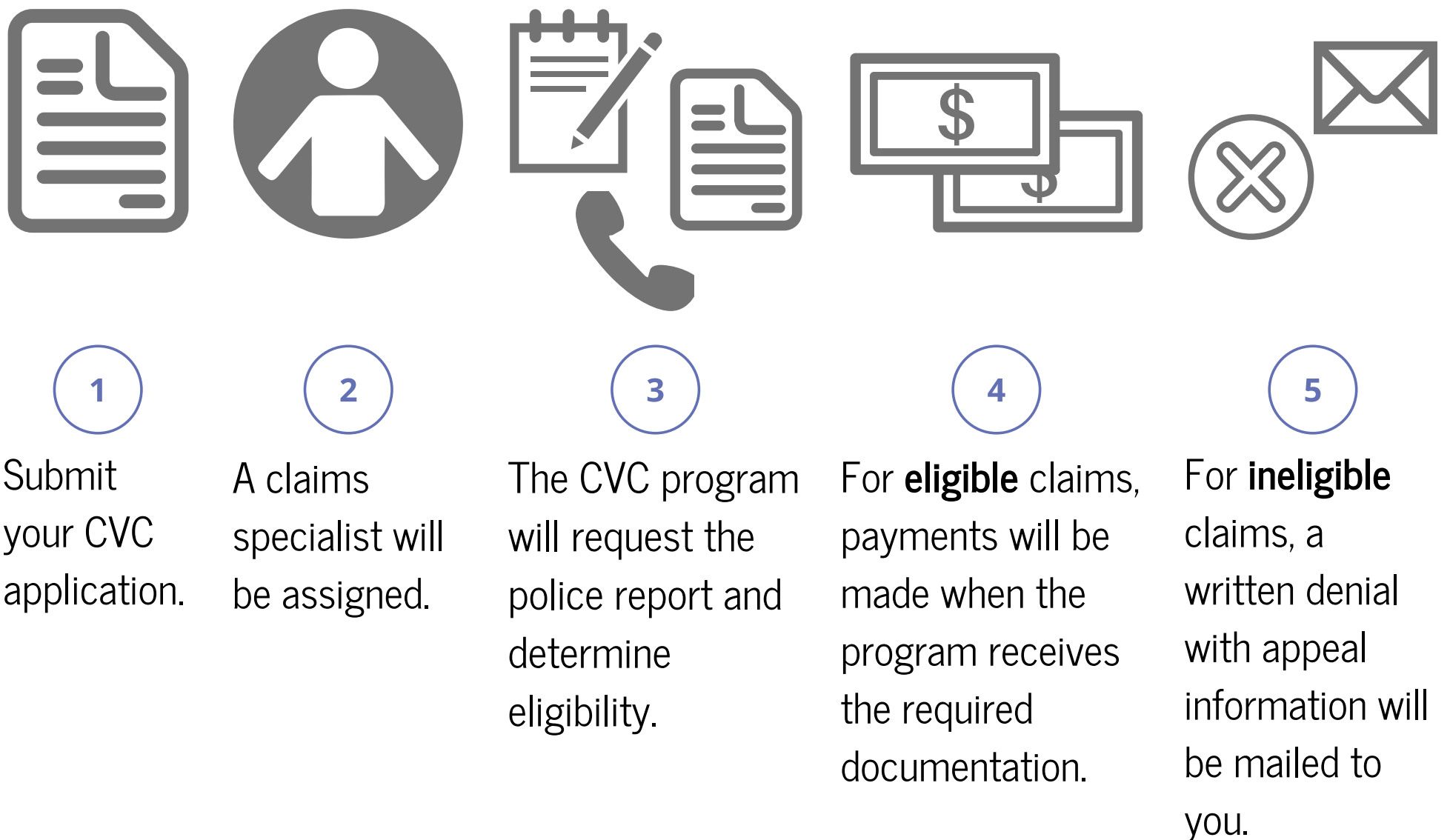
# Wisconsin Crime Victim Compensation Program

## What is Crime Victim Compensation?

Victims of crime **who suffer a personal injury**, and family or household members of deceased victims may have out-of-pocket expenses through no fault of their own.

**Crime Victim Compensation (CVC)** can pay up to \$40,000 or up to four years of eligible crime-related expenses that are not covered by any other source.

## How do you apply?



The time it takes to determine eligibility varies depending on the complexity of the claim. Submitting all requested materials in a timely manner to the CVC Program will help facilitate the processing of your claim.
