Dallas High Risk Victims Model

- Developed/Started 2005
- Goals
 - » Curb or prevent repeat runaway incidents:
 - Identify any prior incidents of sexual abuse and exploitation
 - Redirect from any future delinquent conduct
 - » Bring to an end or curb the victimization of children through sex trafficking and exploitation
 - » Leverage resources through multidisciplinary team

Dallas High Risk Victims Model

- Making the Invisible, *Visible*
 - Finding the hidden victim
- Victim Centered:
 - Intervention
 - Prevention
 - Suppression
- Multidisciplinary Approach/Team
 - Local law enforcement
 - Investigations (Innocence Lost Task Force, ICAC)
 Patrol Officers
 - FBI Innocence Lost
 - Juvenile Dept

Defining the High Risk Victim

- High Risk Victims:
 - Runaways
 - Multiple
 - Sexually exploited
 - Age
 - Repeat victims
 - Victims of child sex trafficking
- Target for recovery/intervention/investigation

Understanding the High Risk Victim

- Unique Victim/Offender Status
 - Not good enough, Not bad enough
- **■** What they are **NOT**:
 - Low Risk
 - Same as Low level / Status offenders
- **What HRV ARE:**
 - High Risk High Need
 - Highest level / potential for potential
 - Victimization
 - Lethality

Challenges Identified

- Unique victim issues
- Lack of specific investigative responsibility
- Traditional investigative models not effective
 - Traditional interview policies not effective
 - Traditional suspect investigative models not effective
- Identifying/Locating the Victim
 - Rarely will "Victims of domestic trafficking" self report

Solutions (Ownership of the Problem)

- Implement Departmental Investigative and Intervention Protocol
 - Immediate 24 hour notification/response for all recovered High Risk Victims
 - Targeted Chronic Runaways (HRV)
 - Victims of trafficking
 - Developed specific HRV interview model
 - Developed specific Investigative model for suspects
 - Established short term placement Juvenile Department (Letot)

Protocol Development

- Assign specific investigative responsibility
 - Unit / detective accountability / responsibility
- Training on dynamics, HRV Model for all:
 - Patrol
 - System Stakeholders
- Evaluation
 - Victims recovered
 - Suspects identified
 - Arrest/prosecution of traffickers
