# 1 REVIEW OF ACT 183

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In August of 2020, the Wisconsin Assembly created a task force to focus on “racial disparities, educational opportunities, public safety, and police policies and standards in Wisconsin.” In its final report, entitled *The Report of the Task Force’s Subcommittee on Law Enforcement Policies and Standards*, the task force offered various recommendations for improving law enforcement practices in Wisconsin. This report was the foundation for 2021 Assembly Bill 329 and 2021 Wisconsin Act 183, which modified Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20).

Enacted on March 17, 2022, 2021 Wisconsin Act 183 created a new section of Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20), which requires the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) to “submit a report to the legislature under Wis. Stat. § 13.172(2) on the issuance and execution of search warrants at physical premises by law enforcement agencies in the prior calendar year” and to provide law enforcement instructions for submitting the data to DOJ. The report is due to the legislature by no later than July 1 of each year.

## 2 PROGRESS TO DATE

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In the last year, BJIA had more workgroup meetings with law enforcement stakeholders where the draft data collection instrument in REDCap was shared. REDCap (Research Electronic Data Capture) is a secure online data collection/management platform used by the WI DOJ for a variety of data collection and research projects. WI DOJ’s instance of REDCap is housed on encrypted DOJ servers. Law enforcement found the instrument to be cumbersome and it was adjusted and simplified based on feedback. It was not yet in use as of the time of this report, and therefore a one-time survey was created in REDCap and sent to law enforcement agencies across the state to collect the data for this report.

These projects, accompanying documentation, and workgroup time were completed by BJIA staff who currently work on other projects<sup>1</sup>, completed in addition to and outside of their regular primary duties.

## 3 2023 LAW ENFORCEMENT DATA

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### Survey Design

For 2023 data, a survey form (see Appendix A) was created in REDCap including questions addressing the required data elements from Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20). The survey was sent via email to all law enforcement agencies in the state.

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<sup>1</sup> In a Fiscal Estimate submitted to the Legislature on June 8, 2021, DOJ requested 1.5 positions to establish, implement, administer, analyze, publish, and report data required by this Act. The Legislature did not act on this request.

## Responses

A total of 362 responses were received. Three surveys, such as one filled out by a district attorney's office, were removed from analyses as it is assumed their warrants are being reported through other law enforcement agencies, and an additional survey was removed due to incompleteness, including the agency name. Any duplicate surveys from agencies were removed after following up with the agencies to confirm the correct submission. The most recent survey response was used for agencies that provided no follow-up response by the time of this report.

## Findings

Of the 358 reports submitted by law enforcement agencies, 134 (37.4%) stated that their agencies had 0 warrants approved or denied for calendar year 2023 (Appendix B), while 224 had at least one (Appendix C). The data below is based on the 224 agencies that reported warrants for 2023.

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(a): The total number of search warrants<sup>2</sup> that were issued and denied.

- **Issued: 2,508**
- **Denied: 2**

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(b): Of the search warrants that were issued, the number that requested explicit authorization of an unannounced entry, and of those that requested explicit authorization of an unannounced entry, the number that explicitly authorized and the number that declined to authorize an unannounced entry.

- **Twelve agencies (Appendix D) requested at least one no-knock warrant.**
  - **Requested no-knock warrant: 24**
    - **Issued: 21**
    - **Denied: 3**

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(c): Of the search warrants that declined to authorize an unannounced entry, the number of search warrants that were executed with an unannounced entry and the number that were executed with an announced entry.

- **Three warrants from two agencies that declined to authorize an unannounced entry were executed with an announced entry.**
- **No warrants that declined to authorize an unannounced entry were executed with an unannounced entry.**

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<sup>2</sup> The survey asked how many search warrants at physical premises that were requested by the agency were approved/issued/denied matching the language in the statute "the issuance and execution of search warrants at physical premises by law enforcement agencies in the prior calendar year." Physical premises were defined in the survey as "a specific location or property that law enforcement officials believe may contain evidence of a crime or contraband, restricted to residences, private businesses, government buildings, correctional facilities, education facilities/institutions, garage/storage units, farms, and religious institutions."

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(d): Of the search warrants that declined to authorize an unannounced entry that were executed with an unannounced entry, all of the following information:

1. The number of warrants for which a return under Wis. Stat. § 968.17 was accompanied by a written inventory of property taken as provided under Wis. Stat. § 968.17(1). **Not applicable- no declined warrants executed with an unannounced entry.**
2. The number of warrant executions that resulted in great bodily harm, as defined in Wis. Stat. § 939.22(14), to any person, or the death of any person. **Not applicable- no declined warrants executed with an unannounced entry.**
3. The age, race, and gender of any primary suspect who was present at the warrant's execution. **Not applicable- no declined warrants executed with an unannounced entry.**

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(e): Of the search warrants that explicitly authorized an unannounced entry, the number of search warrants that were executed with an announced entry and the number that were executed with an unannounced entry.

- **Twelve of 21 warrants that were authorized as no-knock/unannounced entry were executed as knock and announce entry by 11 agencies.**
- **Nine of 21 warrants that were authorized as no-knock/unannounced entry were executed as no-knock/unannounced entry by 3 agencies.**

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(f): Of the search warrants that explicitly authorized an unannounced entry, the type of suspected crime<sup>3</sup> for which it was sought.

- **Murder (3), Negligent Manslaughter (2), Assault (1), Robbery (1), Other Person Offense (1), Burglary (2), Other Property Offense (1), Drug Trafficking (4), Other Drug Offense (1), Public Order Weapons (3), Other Public Order Offense (1), Other Technical Offense (1).**

Wis. Stat. § 165.25(20)(g): Of the search warrants that explicitly authorized an unannounced entry and were executed with an unannounced entry, all of the following information:

1. The number of warrants for which a return under Wis. Stat. § 968.17 was accompanied by a written inventory of property taken as provided under Wis. Stat. § 968.17(1). **Nine of nine warrants.**
2. The number of warrant executions that resulted in great bodily harm, as defined in Wis. Stat. § 939.22(14), to any person, or the death of any person. **No warrants.**
3. The age, race, and gender of any primary suspect who was present at the warrant's execution. **Two men, two Black/African American, two adult primary suspects were present during authorized unannounced/no-knock entries.**

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<sup>3</sup> Agencies could select multiple crime types from a list, and the number of selections could be more than the number of warrants (e.g. one warrant could have had multiple suspected crime types chosen).

A review of this information by jurisdiction is provided in Appendices B-D.

***NOTE: these numbers are from 358 agencies that cover approximately 78% of the state's population. As such, this information is incomplete and should be used for preliminary discussion purposes only. Additionally, the law enforcement agencies that submitted the data are responsible for the accuracy of the data submitted.***

## 4 NEXT STEPS

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BJIA will continue to communicate with workgroup members and the law enforcement community on viable next steps for this data collection program.
