

State of Wisconsin Out-of-State License Affirmation



Instructions. Under Wis. Stat. § 175.60(4)(a)3., an applicant for a Wisconsin license to carry a concealed weapon may satisfy the statutory training requirement by submitting to the Wisconsin Department of Justice a copy of a current or expired license held by the applicant indicating that the applicant is or has been licensed to carry a firearm in this state, in another state, or in a county or municipality of this state or of another state, provided that the current or expired license has not been revoked for cause.

Any concealed carry license applicant wishing to establish proof of training under Wis. Stat. § 175.60(4)(a)3. must complete and sign this form, affirming that the applicant's current or expired license has not been revoked for cause. This form should be included with a copy of the out-of-state license and attached to the application.
