**Milwaukee Man Charged with First Degree Reckless Homicide in  
Connection with Overdose Death**

MADISON, Wis. – The Wisconsin Department of Justice Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) and the Delafield Police Department announced that Terrion D. Walker, 31, of Milwaukee, Wis., was charged with one count of first-degree reckless homicide for his connection with a fentanyl-related overdose death that occurred in Hartland in 2024.

According to the criminal complaint, Walker is alleged to have caused the overdose death after selling a substance containing fentanyl to the victim.

On Tuesday, May 6, 2025, law enforcement officers with the Delafield Police Department and DCI executed a search warrant at Mr. Walker's residence and recovered:

- Approximately 160 grams of cocaine
- Approximately 19.9 grams of fentanyl
- Approximately \$77,000 in cash
- Two firearms

Walker is a convicted felon who is prohibited from possessing a firearm. As in any criminal proceeding, Mr. Walker is presumed innocent until proven guilty. This case is being prosecuted by the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office.

The Delafield Police Department was assisted in this investigation by DCI, the Wisconsin National Guard Counterdrug Program, Homeland Security Investigations,

the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, the Washington County Sheriff's Office, the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office, and the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

This investigation was also supported by the North Central High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) program.
